Donald Bates



Dr Mariana Popescu is the Assistant Professor of Parametric Structural Design and Digital Fabrication at the Delft University of Technology. She is a computational architect and structural designer with a strong interest and experience in innovative ways of approaching the fabrication process and use of materials in construction.

She obtained her PhD in 2019 from ETH Zurich with a research focus on the development of KnitCrete, a novel, material-saving, labour-reducing, cost-effective formwork system for casting doubly-curved geometries in concrete using 3D knitting. She is the main author of the award-winning KnitCandela shell and was named a "Pioneer" in the MIT Technology Review Innovator Under 35 list of 2019.

Professor Donald Bates (LFRAIA; FRIBA) is the Chair of Architectural Design, and Associate Dean (Engagement) for the Faculty of Architecture, Building and Planning at The University of Melbourne.

Bates has taught at the Architectural Association, Cooper Union and other schools, and founded and directed the independent architecture school LoPSiA from 1990-94. In 1994, Prof Bates and Peter Davidson founded LAB Architecture Studio, and in 1997, LAB won the competition for Federation Square, Melbourne. LAB has designed award-winning large-scale commercial, cultural, civic and residential projects, with built works in Australia, Asia, the Middle East, and Europe.
